









#### Missouri Invests Less in its People than Before the Recession: General Revenue Lower than 2008 When Adjusted for Inflation

State General Revenue Relative to Economy Near Record Lows General Revenue as a Percent of Personal Income 1981 – 2015






# Parents as Teachers Cut Nearly in Half Early Investments in Home Visiting Program Provide Children Long-Term Benefits


Eligibility for Child Care Assistance in Missouri is Below the National Average of 182%, Below Most Neighboring States






## Missouri Has Cut State General Revenue Funding for Child Care by 35% Since State Budget Year 2008

Child Care Budget Increasingly Dependent on Federal Funding






## Missouri's Funding Per Child Enrolled in Preschool Falls Well Below National Average, Neighboring States






# State Funding for Education Has Declined as a Portion of Total Funding; State Passes the Buck to Localities





#### In 84% of Missouri Counties, State Funding Per Student Has Failed to Keep Up with Inflation


Combined with Local & Federal Funding, Total Funds Fall Behind in Many Areas






#### Shifting the Burden Toward Local Funding May Result in Troubling Disparities

Total Funding Per Student Varies Greatly Statewide






#### Earnings and Unemployment by Educational Attainment


Funding for 4 Year Public Colleges, Amounts in Millions

Average Tuition & Fees Across 4 Year Public Colleges






#### Eligibility for Medicaid in Missouri Among Lowest in Nation


Income Eligibility Limits for Adults As of January 2015




## Cuts to Department of Mental Health Budgets Leave Vulnerable Missourians Without Care

Department of Mental Health Budget Categories, Fiscal Years 2009-2016 General Revenue Appropriations, Amounts in Millions






# General Revenue Investments in Local Public Health Agencies Cut By Nearly Two-Thirds Since 2001 General Revenue Dollars, in Millions






